**9 events have been carried out within this project:**

**Event 1**

**Participation:** The event involved 15 citizens, including 3 participants from the city of Copenhagen (Denmark),

3 participants from the city of Berlin (Germany), 3 participants Athens (Greece), 3 participants from the city of Budapest (Hungary) and 3 participants Lecce (Italy).

**Location / Dates:** The event took place online (on Skype) from 09/09/2016 to 09/10/2016

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to get to know each other, to sound preparation for activities and distribute responsibilities.

**Event 2**

**Participation:** The event involved 28 citizens, including 2 participants from the city of Copenhagen (Denmark),

6 participants from the cities of Potsdam and Berlin (Germany), 6 participants from the cities of Thessaloniki and Athens (Greece), 6 participants from the cities of Pecs and Budapest (Hungary) and 6 participants from the cities of Milan and Lecce (Italy).

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Lecce, Italy, from 09/10/2016 to 13/10/2016

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to equip facilitators of Restorative Circles with the essential knowledge and skills to lead Circles and to be able to proceed onto the collaborative restorative process design.

**Event 3**

**Participation:** The event involved 111 citizens, including 31 participants from the city of Berlin (Germany),

80 participants from the city of Trebnitz (Germany) etc.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Berlin and Trebnitz, Germany, from 07/01/2017 to 25/06/2017

**Short description:** The aim of the event was over 9 weekends to clarify the views, attitudes, emotions, values and needs of participants relating to the topic of euro-skepticism, to engage them in an open, honest and constructive dialogue.

**Event 4**

**Participation:** The event involved 166 citizens, including 69 participants from the city of Thessaloniki (Greece),

97 participants from the city of Athens (Greece).

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Thessaloniki and Athens, Greece, from 07/01/2017 to

25/06/2017

**Short description:** The aim of the event was over 12 weekends to clarify the views, attitudes, emotions, values and needs of participants relating to the topic of euro-skepticism, to engage them in an open, honest and constructive dialogue.

#### **Event 5**

**Participation:** The event involved 147 citizens, including 98 participants from the city of Budapest (Hungary), 49 participants from the city of Pecs (Hungary).

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Budapest and Pecs, Hungary, from 07/01/2017 to 25/06/2017

**Short description:** The aim of the event was over 10 weekends to clarify the views, attitudes, emotions, values and needs of participants relating to the topic of euro-skepticism, to engage them in an open, honest and constructive dialogue.

#### **Event 6**

**Participation:** The event involved 159 citizens, including 66 participants from the city of Milan (Italy), 93 participants from the city of Lecce (Italy).

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Milan and Lecce, Italy, from 07/01/2017 to 25/06/2017

**Short description:** The aim of the event was over 10 weekends to clarify the views, attitudes, emotions, values and needs of participants relating to the topic of euro-skepticism, to engage them in an open, honest and constructive dialogue.

#### **Event 7**

**Participation:** The event involved 67 citizens, including 58 participants from the city of Copenhagen (Denmark), 8 participants from the city of Silkeborg (Denmark).

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Copenhagen and Silkeborg, Denmark, from 07/01/2017 to 25/06/2017

**Short description:** The aim of the event was over 7 weekends to clarify the views, attitudes, emotions, values and needs of participants relating to the topic of euro-skepticism, to engage them in an open, honest and constructive dialogue.

#### **Event 8**

**Participation:** The event involved 30 citizens, including 6 participants from the city of Copenhagen (Denmark),

6 participants from the city of Berlin (**Germany**), 6 participants Athens (**Greece**), 6 participants from the city of Budapest (**Hungary**) and 6 participants Lecce (Italy).

**Location / Dates:** The event took place online (on Skype), from 01/10/2016 to 31/07/2017

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to keep discussions of the project alive and up-to-date. The facilitators from different countries could mutually gain from each others' experiences. The online meetings ensured the continuous development of the Restorative approach and practice, and leads to better results. Problems were solved together and ideas had been exchange.

#### **Event 9**

**Participation:** The event involved 86 citizens, including 3 participants from the city of Copenhagen (Denmark),

6 participants from the city of Berlin (**Germany**), 6 participants Athens (**Greece**), 68 participants from the city of Budapest (**Hungary**) and 3 participants Lecce (Italy).

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Budapest, Hungary from 21/09/2017 to 24/09/2017

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to summarize and to present the results of the national Circles. Furthermore participants got to know alternative approaches in order to bridge polarities in Europe's societies.
